Nature news

Many areas of the park are left uncut to promote diversity in our wildlife in the park. We had the best display of bluebells and cowslips this year as a result of this sympathetic mowing. We also have pyramidal orchids growing around the park.

In the Walled Garden an area that has been left to grow has this year around 50 bee orchids growing.
