FAQ

What happens if it rains? You get wet, in extreme weather or thunderstorms performances may be delayed or cancelled however the theatre groups will make every effort to continue with the performance.

Can I bring a picnic? Yes, also bring something to sit on and some warm clothes for evening performances as it can get chilly.

Are there toilets? Yes we have a toilet block in the Walled Garden that is open on event days.

Can I bring my dog? Yes dogs are welcome on a lead.

Is there car parking? Staff will guide you to one of our three car parks that are all a short walk away from the Garden.

Our tennis courts are out of action due to subsidence of the surface of the whole area. It is very costly to repair the courts, we are looking into ways to get at least one tennis court available to use.


Nature news

Many areas of the park are left uncut to promote diversity in our wildlife in the park.

In addition we have a new sensory garden on the Mansion lawn which you get to by crossing over Porters Park Drive from the Pond. The area in front of the mansion up to the yew buttresses is part of Shenley Park. There is no access to the Mansion itself, it was converted many years ago into private residences.

The garden has been planted with wildflowers and is exceptionally beautiful, worth a visit.





















Apples

We have two orchards, the historic Stanley Lord Orchard and a newer orchard planted over the last 5 years on the mansion lawn. We do ask that people do not pick the apples, we sell both apples when available and the juice that we make from the apples through our produce stall in the Walled Garden. All proceeds go directly into the upkeep of the Park, as we are a self-financing park run by a charitable trust this is important to us.

Apples

Dependent on our apple crop we do plan to hold apple picking afternoons for families to come and help us pick (in accordance with any Covid guidelines). These would be at weekends from September, notices will be around the park and website.

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Shenley Park is managed by the charity Shenley Park Trust, which is self financing receiving no monies from Shenley Parish Council, Hertsmere or Herts County Council.
