### Nature news

Many areas of the park are left uncut to promote diversity in our wildlife in the park. We have many more bats around the Park, look out for them in the evenings they are very active around 30 minutes before sunset.

If you have not visited the wildflowers on the Mansion lawn yet do, they are still looking great.





## Apples

We have two orchards, the historic Stanley Lord Orchard and a newer orchard planted over the last 5 years on the mansion lawn. These are heritage apples that are not found in supermarkets, and we are privileged to be protecting these unusual and increasingly rare varieties.

We do ask that people do not pick the apples, we sell both apples when available and the juice that we make from the apples through our produce stall in the Walled Garden.

All proceeds go directly into the upkeep of the Park, as we are a self-financing park run by a charitable trust this is important to us.



### Apples

We are holding an apple picking afternoon on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September. We have received a lot of interest in this so we are in effect full for this date now. Our apples are ripening quickly and so we are busy picking. If there are enough apples we will hold another picking session on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> September. Please email shenleypark@gmail.com.
