Spring is here and some great sunny weather is drying the ground up at last.

We have been busy in the park. The orchard has been selectively pruned together with coppicing wild areas. A new path extension laid along the top path by the tennis courts.

We have received feedback that our other new stretch of footpath resurfacing at the bottom of the meadow is too stony. We are looking into topping this with a finer stone.

Our grass has been cut for the first time, we will have selective long areas of grass around the park throughout the growing season.

The Walled Garden and amphitheatre have also been mown for the first time so we really feel spring is here and summer round the corner.



Daffodils and other spring flowers are out, come and see 12-4pm weekdays.

The Garden will be open on Mothers Day 12-4pm and then from Easter to October also at weekends 12-4pm.

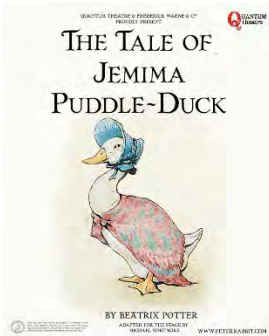
